

# What to do prior to beginning your import



## Before you begin your import

- Complete the consensus form in all of your included studies
- Included studies must have study IDs (#12 Brown 2024)
- Enable Study-centric data in RevMan Web
- Add interventions and outcome names to RevMan Web
- Add Identification as a user defined Characteristic
- Set up your analyses (optional)
- Import the references from Covidence

## Steps to export data from Covidence to RevMan Web

Export csv files from Covidence:

- Study information
- Study arms
- Study results
- Risk of bias (RoB 1)
- Custom data





#### What does Covidence not support?

- RoB 2
- Custom data direct import
- Direct reference import
- Automatic population of subgroup data
